- *Youth may compete on horses owned by others no owner restrictions
- * Horse must be at least 7 years of age and may be stallions
- *Horse must be USEF Recorded and hold either a National Passport or FEI Passport prior to qualification. All other required forms can be completed at the qualifier
- *Qualification for selection consideration requires one run with a minimum score (67)
- *Two teams of 4 riders each will be selected (Junior Riders/Young Riders)
- *All qualifying runs will be considered for selection by the selection committee
- *Riders must declare which age division they are competing in (Young or Junior)
- *Riders may compete for consideration in both age divisions if the rider age falls between the ages of 16 18 but must do so at separate qualifiers
- *Riders' age is considered from the beginning of the year in which they are showing
- **a rider turning 16 in 2019 is considered 16 as of Jan. 1, 2019 until Dec. 31, 2019
- *Riders can complete the qualifier for selection on a horse other than the one they intend to compete on if selected to TEAM USA
- *No quarantined stalling required at qualifier
- *After completion of the trot test, youth rider is the only rider allowed on horse
- *Competition attire required for trot test (held after the completion of the nonpro/7UP class on Saturday)

- *Helmet required for competition if rider is under the age of 18
- *Qualifying class runs concurrently with NRHA Youth/AQHA Youth/Unrestricted Youth Classes...classes may be cross entered with qualifier if NRHA ownership/age rules are met
